Post doctoral fellowships Epilepsy and EEG 2021

Broad objective:

The post doctoral fellowship (PDF) in epilepsy and Electroencephalography is designed to offer high quality training in clinical epileptology and management of refractory epilepsy and other areas of specialized care such as epilepsy in women, young children and elderly. The EEG component focuses on clinical electrophysiology, routine EEG, Video EEG for seizure monitoring and intra operative monitoring, electrocorticography and its application in epilepsy care including epilepsy surgery.

Eligibility

The candidate should have passed DM Neurology or equivalent courses approved by the Medical Council of India.

Duration 12 months

The program starts on 1st January each year and will end on 31 December.

Course curriculum

The candidate will be rotated through the various aspects of clinical epileptology in a systematic manner

Epilepsy Monitoring Unit

The PDF is expected to take the history and physicals and write the case record of each patient admitted under his / her care in the EMU and do all necessary work up of the case. He or she shall under the supervision of the consultant plan the monitoring protocol including the need for

additional electrodes, sphenoidal electrodes, ictal SPECT and special sequences of MRI if required. They would familiarize themselves with the standard protocols for observing a seizure and testing the cognitive and language functions of the patients during and immediately after the seizure. They will participate in intracranial stimulation studies and EEG / FMRI studies Wada Test that are carried out in the EMU. PDF shall review the video EEG of the patient independently and present it to the consultant who is doing the VEEG reporting on a daily basis. It would be the PDF's responsibility to ensure that the VEEG segments are properly edited by the neurotechnologist and archived appropriately. The PDF will participate in the patient management meeting and present and discuss the case with regard to the management. He or she shall be responsible for completing the discharge summary for the patients admitted under his or her care.

Epilepsy Surgery OT

They are expected to attend to the Neurosurgery OT whenever there is an epilepsy surgery. They need to familiarize themselves with the intracranial electrode placements, electrocorticography, awake craniotomy, and other procedures related to epilepsy surgery in the OT.

Outpatient service

The PDF shall attend to the Epilepsy clinic (EP1 and EP2) on a regular basis and participate in patient management. During these services, they are expected to acquire skills in history taking, work up of routine cases, identification of non epileptic conditions, refractory epilepsy and management of epilepsy in special situations and special populations such as elderly. The PDF shall also gain skills in counselling patients and the family members with regard to diverse aspects of epilepsy and its management.

ICU and other department consultations

This will be an opportunity for the PDF to gain expertise in managing status epilepticus, seizures in ICU and emergency departments. They will also attend to consultations from other departments regarding seizures or epilepsy or its complications.

Epilepsy and Pregnancy Registry

During the program the PDF shall spent three months attached to the registry of epilepsy and pregnancy and gain expertise in preconception care, managing epilepsy during pregnancy, breast feeding, follow up of children of women with epilepsy, special problems related to infertility, bone health and contraception.

Outreach program & Medical camps

The PDF shall attend to the monthly outreach program(s) of the RMNC a period of three months and attend to at least two medical camps organized by the RMNC

Patient Management Meeting

The PDF shall prepare the cases for presentation in the PMC and make available all the necessary data. They shall also take active participation in discussing the management of cases presented in the PMC and prepare the PMC notes for each of the patient.

Research Project.

Research activities shall be an important component of the fellowship. Each fellow is expected to complete a research project as per the calendar given below
